

Caring For your New Lenses



Congratulations!

on purchasing your new anti-reflective lenses from Nelson Family Eyecare !

Here are a few helpful hints to care for your lenses and to help keep them looking new and scratch free. Plastic based lenses with antiglare coating allow for the great optics, protection, and are lightweight. However, no lens -glass or plastic- is fully scratch-proof!

- 1) Always store your glasses in your case/ make sure the inside stays clean

- 2) To clean your lenses, use the spray & cleaning cloth we provided
 - spray the inside of the lenses
 - rub lenses between your fingers
 - dry with cloth (be sure to keep cloth clean - they can be washed)

- 3) Another option: luke-warm to cold water with a bit of hand soap. DO NOT use hot water on the lenses
(you may damage the coating with constant use of hot water)
 - rinse lenses with water
 - lather a small amount of soap on fingers and rub lenses
 - rinse with water
 - dry with clean cloth

- 4) AVOID
 - wearing your glasses into saunas, hot tubs, mineral pools etc.
 - exposing to heat: leaning into an oven or woodstove
 - leaving your glasses in direct heat source, i.e. windowsill or dashboard
 - using any glass cleaners on lenses i.e. windex
 - rubbing your lenses dry (rinse first)
 - aerosol sprays i.e. hair spray or cleaning agents (rinse thoroughly with water)
